Change of weight class at weigh-in: 10 EUR
- For every five registered athletes per discipline, the 6th athlete participates free of charge. "5+1"**

Athletes without an opponent will either receive a refund of the entry fee or can be listed as the only first-place person in their category and get the gold medal.

The payment confirmation must be presented at the time of registration.
If athletes do not show up, the entry fee will be forfeited!

Liability: All persons involved in the event in any form participate in the event at their own risk. Neither the organizer nor the promoter assumes any liability of any kind. By submitting the entry, the participant expressly agrees to the exclusion of liability.

Prerequisite for participation:

Valid ÖTDV ID card or corresponding national TKD ID card from foreign clubs. Medical certificate not older than 1 year for Kyorugi. Timely entry and payment of the entry fee. Declaration of consent for participants under 18 years of age.

The organizer points out that video and photo recordings will be made and used for marketing purposes. By registering, participants give their permission to publish these recordings.

Performance class LK 1, from 2nd Kup:

TOURNAMENT MODE: Cut-off system according to the rules of World Taekwondo

Requirement of the Poomsae:

All participants run the same Poomsae per round. For each round, two Poomsae are drawn from the compulsory area of the respective age group, which are to be performed one after the other. There is a break of minimum 30 seconds between the two Poomsae, during which the athletes can join their coaches at the edge of the competition area or stand still on the mat.

Depending on the number of starters in a class, one, two or three rounds are run.

1st round (preliminary round; from 20 participants): The best 50 % (rounded) qualify for the next round, the points are not taken to the next round.

2nd round (semifinal round; 9 to 19 participants): The best 6 athletes advance to the final, the points are not carried over to the final round.

3rd round (final round; 1 to 8 participants).

Couples and team competitions:

In LK1, only mixed couples (f/m) and same-sex teams (f/f/f) or (m/m/m) are allowed.

Draw of the mandatory Poomsae in the performance class LK 1: The draw of the Poomsae takes place the day before the championship. The Poomsae will be sent to the registered teams by e-mail and published on the website of the Vienna Taekwondo Federation wtdv.at and announced on site.

Performance class LK 2 (10th – 3rd Kup): Age groups like performance class 1

TOURNAMENT MODE: Cut-off system according to the rules of World Taekwondo

1st round (preliminary round; from 9 participants):

Two Poomsae of the athlete's choice according to the table, the best 50 % of participants by points qualify for the next round. In the event of an odd number of participants, the number of participants will be rounded up (11 starters = 6 advanced), in the event of a tie by points, all athletes concerned will advance (13 starters, 3 athletes tied on points in 7th place = 9 starters).

2nd round (final round; 1 to 8 participants):

Two Poomsae of the athlete's choice according to the table.

10th and 9th Kup: Repetition of both Poomsae from the 1st round in the final possible.

8th and 7th Kup: Repetition of both Poomsae from the 1st round in the final possible.

6th and 5th Kup: Repetition of **one** Poomsae from the 1st round in the final possible.

4th and 3rd Kup: **No repetition** of any Poomsae from a previous round allowed.

Pair and team competitions:

The selection range of Poomsae depends on the person with the highest graduation.

In the Junior championship (LK2), pairs and teams can also be formed across age limits, but the classification of the age group is based on the oldest member of a pair / team. In LK2, mixed teams (female + male) are possible in the team competition (3 participants) in all age groups.

Scoring system:

The scoring is carried out according to the specifications of WT with an electronic scoring system.

Only the result lists sent out by the competition management after the tournament are valid.

Honorary gifts:

Medals for places 1 to 3. For the club ranking, only hard-fought placings are considered.

Basics of the FREESTYLE Poomsae:

The music for the freestyle competition must be sent to office@wtdv.at by e-mail in the form of an mp3 file by the entry deadline. To be on the safe side, please also have a USB stick ready, provided with your name and, if several pieces of music/files are stored on it, the corresponding track number and division.

The scoring is based on the World Taekwondo Poomsae Competition Rules.

For details regarding the composition (mandatory techniques, ...) see the WT Freestyle Poomsae Rules.

FREESTYLE-Poomsae mode:

Regardless of the number of participants, only one round (final) will be run, in which all participants present their Freestyle Poomsae once.

Kyorugi

Performance class: LK1 from 4th Kup (all age groups)
LK2 from 9th Kup to 5th Kup (all age groups)
Master (LK1 only) from 4th Kup, from 41 years (year group)

Competition rules: World Taewondo – Best of three system.

Competition time: 3 x 1.5 minutes – 30 seconds rest

Juniors (born in 2009) are free to start in the Juniors OR Seniors division.

Division merges – The mode for any mergers is as follows: An athlete without an opponent is promoted to the next higher weight class in their own performance category. Athletes without an opponent will either receive a refund of the entry fee or can be listed as the only first-place person in their category and get a gold medal.

Notes Kyorugi:

All competitions will be carried out with electronic competition vests from Daedo (Gen3). – Daedo sensor socks must be provided by yourself (eventually sales booth on site).

Equipment: Head protection, groin protection, forearm protection, shin protection and mouth protection (white or transparent), gloves are compulsory (WT-compliant only!).

COACHES:

In addition to generally good behavior, the following rules apply to coaches:

- Aged 18 or older
- Only long pants and indoor shoes are permitted at the coaching position next to the competition area; no dobok
- No cell phones or other electronic devices
- No glass bottles

The final schedule will be sent to the participating clubs until 06 November 2026 by e-mail.

General information for Poomsae and Kyorugi:

All participants must wear the belt colour corresponding to their respective graduation level.
White Dobok is compulsory, not a black lapel for colour belts.

Honorary gifts: Medals for places 1 to 3. For the club ranking, only hard-fought placings are considered, no last places.

Hall rules: There is one coach per club, for four or more competitors two coaches and for ten or more competitors three coaches have free access to the hall. Access to the competition area is only permitted for fighters and coaches in appropriate clothing (dobok, suit or tracksuit, indoor shoes).

WTDV disciplinary regulations for this Championship:

The WTDV also reserves the right to prohibit persons from entering the tournament or not to accept registrations.

Note: For the Kyorugi and Poomsae competitions, white Dobok is mandatory, black lapel is only allowed for Dan grades!

Award ceremony: Only in dobok or tracksuit – no street clothes!

Protest court: The protest court and any changes regarding the organizational course of the event will be announced at the team captains' meeting.
